Anne Schulp (23), student at the Faculty of Earth Sciences at the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, will talk about: *Dinosaurs of the Maastrichtian of France, Spain and the Sultanate of Oman*. Mr Schulp studies paleontology of dinosaurs of the Maastrichtian under guidance of prof. Boekschoten. The speaker provided the following abstract:

Dinosaurs of the Maastrichtian of France, Spain and the Sultanate of Oman

The story comprises five subjects:

- *A short introduction into dinosaurs: an overview of a the great diversity of species*
- *Digging for dino's: what is it all about. Methods and techniques are illustrated showing a day at the excavations at Campagne-sur-Aude, a little town in the South of France.*
- *...Oucomes of excavations. An overview of the dinosaur fauna of the Maastrichtian of Southern-Europe. Titanosaurs and small Ornithopods. The carnivorous Variraptor. Turtles, crocodiles and flying reptiles. Giant birds and their relation to dinosaurs.*
- *Foot prints: dinosaurs jogging in the Pyrenees. What do foot prints tell about dinosaur behaviour? Information about their speed of movement, their daily business, environment and social behaviour.*

- *Conclusive remarks: zooming out world wide on the Upper Cretaceous: dinosaurs of the Sultanate of Oman and Canada. Canadian dinosaurs on exhibit in The Hague, dinosaurs from the Sultanate of Oman: an account of our recent Oman expedition and the relationship between Northern (= Canadian) and Southern (French, Spanish, Omani) dinosaurs*
