Arjan Dijkstra and Martyn Drury (University of Utrecht) will speak about the Oman ophiolites:

In the first part of the talk, the typical rock sequence as found in the Oman Ophiolite will be discussed. This is probably the largest, best-exposed and best-studied ophiolite in the world. Despite many similarities with the present-day ocean floor, there are also significant differences. Current ideas regarding the formation and emplacement of the ophiolite will be addressed. In the second part of the presentation, focus will be on the information that can be extracted from the mantle section of the ophiolite. The research has focussed on structures related to high-temperature deformation in the mantle. Detailed mapping and microstructural study shows that previous interpretations of these structures are probably incorrect. This has important consequences for models of mantle flow at ocean ridges.

After the annual meeting we will enjoy our annual dinner, from 20:15 PM onwards in restaurant de Hooischaar, Hooistraat 1a, Den Haag. The costs will be 50 guilders per person to be transferred to one of the PGK accounts. Those who wish to attend please complete the form beneath and return it to the secretary before February 20th.
